Kelly Hancock was named Acting Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts on July 1, 2025. As Comptroller, he oversees the state treasury, tax collection and state revenue estimates. The office also manages initiatives that include Texas' new education savings account program, broadband expansion, opioid abatement funding, rural law enforcement grants and more.

Kelly has a long history of public service, which began with him serving 13 years on his local school board. He served in the Texas Legislature for nearly 20 years, first in the House and then in the Senate. He is a strong advocate for the conservative values of limited government and lower taxes.

A native Texan, Kelly is the founding owner/operator of a family business. He holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from Baylor University. He and his wife, Robin, have three children and are proud grandparents to six young Texans.
